

# Brookside Pool Rules

**This pool is a Daybreak resident exclusive amenity. Use of this pool is for residents and their guests only. All guests must be accompanied by a Daybreak resident at all times.**

- 1. Persons 14 years of age and over must have a valid Daybreak resident ID to be admitted to the facility. Children 13 years of age and younger must be accompanied by a responsible resident of Daybreak 18 years of age or older.**
- 2. A responsible individual 18 years of age or older must accompany all children under 9 in the water and be within arms reach at all times.**
- 3. Smoking and alcohol are prohibited on the premises.**
- 4. Running, roughhousing, dunking, chicken fights and abusive language are not permitted.**
- 5. Diving, flips, twists, back dives and all other unsafe activities are prohibited.**
- 6. For handicap lift, please ask pool staff for assistance.**
- 7. In order to lap swim, you must be able to swim consistently without assistance.**
- 8. Visitors, spectators or animals must not be allowed within 10 feet of the pool edge. Service animals are exempt from this requirement. No dogs in the pool.**
- 9. Food or drink must be prohibited within ten feet of the pool edge. All beverages within the pool compound must be in non-breakable containers.**
- 10. Trash containers must be provided. The entire pool facility area must be kept free of litter and maintained in a clean, sanitary condition.**
- 11. Diapers must only be changed in restrooms or changing stations. Persons who change the diaper must wash their hands thoroughly with soap and water before returning to the pool. The diapered person must undergo a cleansing shower before returning to the pool.**
- 12. Only the following items are allowed in the pool:**
  - Soft or inflatable pool toys 12" or less in diameter**
  - Water noodles**
  - Coastguard approved personal flotation devices**
  - Water wings**

## Spa Rules

The following individuals should consult a physician prior to using the spa:

- Elderly individuals
- Individuals suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high blood pressure
- Persons using prescription drugs
- Pregnant women

**Bathers should not use the spa alone**

**Bathers should not spend more than 15 minutes in the spa in any one session**

**Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied/supervised by a responsible individual 18+**

**Running, horseplay or engaging in unsafe activities by or around the spa is prohibited**

The following individuals are not permitted to use the spa:

- Persons suffering from a communicable disease transmissible via water
- Individuals under the influence of alcohol or other impairing chemical substances
- Children under the age of 5

# Personal Hygiene and Behavior Rules

1. A bather using the facility must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool enclosure. A bather leaving the pool to use the toilet must take a second cleansing shower before returning to the pool enclosure.
2. A person having a communicable disease transmissible by water must be excluded from pools. A person having any exposed sub-epidermal tissue, including open blisters, cuts, or other lesions may not use a pool. A person who has or has had diarrhea within the last two weeks caused by an unknown source or from any communicable or fecal-borne disease may not enter any public pool.
3. Any child under three years old, any child not toilet trained, and anyone who lacks control of defecation must wear a water-resistant swim diaper and waterproof swimwear. Swim diapers and waterproof swimwear must have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference.
4. Running, boisterous, or rough play, except supervised water sports is prohibited.
5. Diapers must be changed in restrooms or changing stations not at poolside. The person or persons who change the diaper must wash their hands thoroughly with soap before returning to the pool. The diapered person must undergo a cleansing shower before returning to the pool.
6. Visitors, spectators, or animals must not be allowed within 10 feet of the pool edge. Service animals are exempt from this requirement.
7. Food or drink must be prohibited within ten feet of the pool edge. All beverages within the pool compound must be in non-breakable containers.
8. Trash containers must be provided. The entire pool facility area must be kept free of litter and maintained in a clean, sanitary condition.

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
