

Liberty Pool Rules

1. All patrons are required to show their military ID card to the lifeguard upon pool facility entry. Each household will be required to sign in on the log to enter the facility – NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. All guests must be accompanied by a Liberty resident and must fill out a liability waiver to enter the facility.
3. No running, diving, or flipping into the pool. Swimmers must jump into the pool facing forward, feet first.
4. No dunking, rough play, breath holding, or sitting/standing on shoulders.
5. No hanging or playing on stair handrails.
6. Balls and other toys are allowed but may not be used as flotation devices. Usage is at the discretion of the lifeguard based on patron safety.
7. Profanity is prohibited.
8. Infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers while in the pool.
9. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 years.
10. Smoking, vaping, alcohol, and glass of any kind are prohibited.
11. Lifeguards will call 10-minute safety breaks @ 1pm, 3pm, and 5pm.
- 12. Patrons will observe all posted rules and requests made by the lifeguards.**
